

The Boyz Cabernet Shiraz 2004

Five Sons Estate The Boyz wine reflects the fun and freedom of youth and should be drunk with the same pleasure.

Our 2004 The Boyz Cabernet Shiraz was processed in two parcels, 70% undergoing fermentation in a closed fermenter, the remaining 30% in an open fermenter where it was pumped over and plunged to ensure good tannin and colour extraction. Fermentation was completed in eight days using cultured yeast at a temperature of 30 degrees before fermentation for fourteen months in French and American oak barriques.

This blend combines the best of each variety. Intense blackcurrant and red berry fruit flavours of cabernet merge with the smooth plum and spice of shiraz. The palate is soft and full with supple and well integrated tannins.
