

# The Boyz Chardonnay 2006

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Five Sons Estate The Boyz wine reflects the fun and freedom of youth and should be drunk with the same pleasure.

The fruit for our 2006 The Boyz Chardonnay was pressed and the juice settled in stainless steel tanks for twenty four hours. The juice was then racked and underwent a cool fermentation for three weeks at about 14 degrees, 80% in stainless steel with 20% fermented in French oak barriques, 5% of which were new.

The wine was matured for a further six months in these vessels before filtration and bottling.

Our 2006 The Boyz Chardonnay has the aroma of stone fruit, particularly white peach, and melon as well as subtle spicy oak characters. The soft, balanced palate shows characters of pineapple, melon and a touch of honey with fresh acid providing a full and rich mouth feel.
